
On the horizon:




Fall season has arrived! This is a very exciting and extremely busy time, now until the end of the year for our fabulous decorating committee. Our

Recreational Boaters of California, I did not know how scary the words "the legislature will be working until midnight to get the final bills passed" really are.

There is some news on the national front, as the House and Senate continue to work. The appropriations bill passed without the Calvert Rider, so the WaterFix is still subject to judicial review. Thanks to all those that responded to our "call to arms" and made their congressman and senators aware of our opposition to the rider. America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018 passed and will be signed by the President. Good news for boaters across the country. The Modern Fish act, updating fisheries laws has passed and will be signed. The battle against 15% ethanol blends that are so harmful to marine engines is not going well. The administration has authorized the year round sales of the 15% blend. We are still fighting for plain gas at marine fuel docks.

RBOC anxiously awaits the new proposals from the state legislature for 2019 and we will begin the process all over again.
