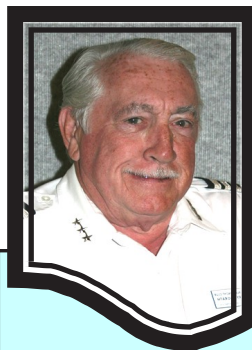

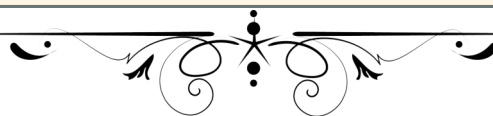
As this is my last report, I want to thank all you members who put up with me and supported the Bar all year at the risk of your livers and kidneys, most of you don't look any worse for the wear.

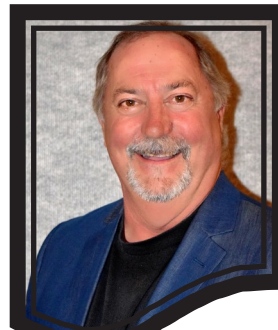

Document to bring them up to today's actuality.

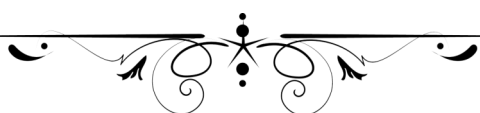
In the coming months we will continue to tweak both documents to eliminate any discrepancies.

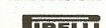
